Our Shared Life and Ministry



February's Monthly Ministry Partner is **Lutheran World Relief**. At the broadest level, LWR's mission is "to relieve suffering and poverty and to promote justice around the world." Each week, this space will highlight an aspect of LWR's work and offer a way that we can get involved. To wit: the Lutheran Malaria Initiative brings together a worldwide network of partner churches, missionaries and service providers in an effort to eliminate malaria deaths in Africa by 2015. Malaria, a treatable and preventable disease, takes the life of a child every 45 seconds. According to the World Health Organization, nearly a million of the more than 200 million cases of malaria each year result in death, the majority being pregnant women and children under the age of five. A donation of just \$10 provides a treated bed net to families trying to avoid malaria.

It will complement the preach-in on global warming on February 12, which LCI will observe as part of the California Interfaith Power and Light movement. We will watch a portion of the film each week and have a brief time for discussion afterwards. Youth are encouraged to attend.
