Interim Pastor's Report April 28 – May 31, 2025

Pastoral Reflection - A look back and a look ahead

I went "on the clock" as your Interim Pastor on Monday, April 28 and it has been a good time. I have enjoyed leading worship for these four Sundays as well as being in the office and visiting people. The early lack of cooling in the office area has been resolved – a breaker was in the off position in the electrical room – so I will resume office hours on Thursday afternoons beginning on June 12th.

Highlights of the last month include the Synod's new method of Assembly with a series of regional gatherings. Tim, Kathryn, and I were at the first of three scheduled gatherings in Chico on May 10.

The theme of the event was "Hope" as inspired by Chapter 4 of Paul's 2nd letter to the Corinthians, which says in verses 7-10: "But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed."

While I don't think life today is as challenging as it was in the early first century, the current challenges are real and substantial and were duly acknowledged at the assembly. "**Do Not Lose Heart**" was the theme of the scheduled keynote address, though the keynote speaker was unable to attend. The address as well as other activities were designed to explore "themes of hope in the midst of great challenges in our church and in our world." I feel that the gathering tried hard to provide small group interaction to fulfill the goal.

Our Synod Assembly will continue with two Zoom gatherings. The first is June as we conduct elections and deal with resolutions. The second will be November 1 when delegates will discuss and vote on a Synod budget.

Another highlight was when Marjan delivered the quilts/banners for our Pentecost season. Carol Huegli and I were very impressed and excited to see them, and I believe you will be when they are on full display beginning on June 15th.

EIGHTH EXTENSION TO LEASE AND ELEVENTH AMENDMENT TO LEASE

PARTIES:

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 23th day of April, 2025 by and between Lutheran Church of the Incarnation, a California corporation, (herein called "Landlord" or "LCI") and APPLEGATE NURSERY SCHOOL, a California corporation, (herein called "Tenant" or "Applegate").

RECITALS:

- A. Landlord and Tenant entered into a written Lease Agreement dated July 1, 1999, and First Extension to Lease dated July 22, 2000, and a First Amendment to Lease dated June 8, 2001, Second Amendment dated April 17, 2002, and a Second Extension and Third Amendment dated July 16, 2003, and a Fourth Amendment dated August 29, 2005, and a Third Extension to Lease and Fifth Amendment to Lease dated December 28, 2006 (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Lease"), and a Sixth Amendment to Lease dated March 16, 2008, Fourth Extension to Lease and Seventh Amendment to Lease dated May 19, 2009, and a Fifth Extension to Lease and Eighth Amendment to Lease dated July 8, 2012, and a Sixth Extension to Lease and Ninth Amendment to Lease dated July 10, 2017, Seventh Extension to Lease and Tenth Amendment to Lease, for the lease of certain premises located in the City of Davis, County of Yolo, State of California (hereinafter referred to as the "Premises"), and more specifically located at 1701 Russell Boulevard; and
- B. Landlord and Tenant desire by this agreement to amend the Lease subject to conditions and provisions hereinafter contained.

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the mutual agreements herein contained and for valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, Landlord and Tenant do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. **Term:** The term of Lease covering the premises above described shall be extended for a period of approximately five (5) years commencing November 1, 2025 and ending August 31, 2030 (herein referred to as the "Eighth Extended Term").
- 2. **Rent:** The Monthly Rent during the Term 11/1/2025-8/31/2030 shall be as follows:

Commencing on November 1, 2025 and adjusted annually on September 1 through August 31, 2030, the annual monthly rent shall be increased by 4% as follows:

- November 1, 2025 the rent shall be \$32,522 annually/\$2,710 monthly
- September 1, 2026 the rent shall be \$33,823 annually/\$2,818 monthly
- September 1, 2027 the rent shall be \$35,176 annually /\$2,931 monthly
- September 1, 2028 the rent shall be \$36,583 annually/\$3,048 monthly
- September 1, 2029 the rent shall be \$38,047 annually/\$3,170 monthly

- 3. Additional Lease Term: Notwithstanding any existing or past understanding, practice or agreement of the parties, Landlord shall be entitled to place and maintain at all times work on all parts of the Premises any wall hangings, quilts, crafts, decorations, signage, pictures, devices, or other matters that the Landlord may desire to place, post, or display. Tenant may temporarily cover, without removing or taking down, any such items during Tenant's periods of exclusive use with an easily-removable covering, but shall remove the covering whenever it is not in exclusive possession of the Premises.
- 4. **Liability Insurance:** Tenant's Liability coverage is to be Primary and Non-Contributory
- 5. **Counterparts:** Except as otherwise modified above, Landlord and Tenant agree that all this agreement may be executed in counterparts, each which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. This agreement may not be amended or modified except in writing signed by the parties hereto.
