What is a Housing Trust Fund and why should I care?

On Sunday December 3 following the service, Georgina Valencia, a former Social Services Commissioner, a current Planning Commissioner and a long time proponent of the Housing Trust Fund will share how a well funded Housing Trust Fund can help our city provide solutions for the unsheltered, aid in the creation of more low income housing, provide safety net services to keep our neighbors housed and help our young people purchase housing in Davis. This is a timely issue, as The City of Davis is placing a revenue measure on the November 2024 ballot which can include funding for the Housing Trust Fund if we as citizens demand it. Join us for a light lunch and learn about how we can support those needing housing with our voice and our vote.
