LCI is being asked to reconsider participating in the HEART safe parking pilot program in Davis. This program supports the 200+ unhoused population in Davis. Up to 3 vehicles per night would have access to a designated parking spot and a key to the port-a-potty. A HEART security guard would check on the tenants 3x/night. They would arrive by 8pm and be required to depart by 7am (before staff and parents arrive). This puts less concern on the safety of Applegate. Kathryn to research our insurance policy. Ellen to provide further feedback. Tim to locate where the port-a-potty could be located. LCI could commit to 1 month and see how it goes. Council to revisit this topic in February.

#### **Pastor's Report**

January 13, 2025 Lutheran Church of the Incarnation Pastor Dan Smith

#### **Action Items:**

Acceptance of matching gift of \$2,500 for L.A. fire relief, from an anonymous family at LCI. This means we would promote the matching gift to encourage donations to Lutheran Disaster Response to help relief efforts for the L.A. fires. Please keep the victims of the fires in L.A. in your prayers... they have a long road ahead of them...

#### **Information Items:**

**Christmas Eve worship** – we had very good attendance both at our 3:00 and 5:00pm services; especially families with children at 3pm as well as 5pm. I am currently working on following up with guests and visitors. The earlier time seemed to work well especially for families with young children, which was our goal.

CORRECTION: **Celebration of Abraham is Feb. 2, 2025** (my previous report said Feb. 9). The theme is "Finding Strength to Move through Challenges" (see attached flyer – and share with others!!). We are hosting at LCI, and I highly recommend the experience of connection, sharing and listening.

**Adult Forum:** We will have special guests at our adult forum, 2/9 at 9:00am – "Abraham in Judaism, Christianity and Islam"), to conclude my current class on ecumenical theology. Michael Hirsch of Congregation Bet Haverim and Kamal Lemseffler of the Islamic Center of Davis (both on the Abraham planning committee). Join us!

**Pub Theology** – continues 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesdays, 7pm at Pizza and Pints.

<u>Sabbatical:</u> I have nearly completed my sabbatical planning (see attachment). I have met with Abajh Singh about developing a theme and doing some extra fundraising. I am deeply grateful to the congregation for offering this opportunity for learning, growth, reflection and most for rest and renewal. Rev. Bob Willse (retired) has offered to cover for most of the preaching and pastoral care duties. The congregation will need to engage Bob around details of work expectations, pay, etc.

<u>Otherwise:</u> I have finished my class at PLTS, and look forward to a break... My translation project (Baylor University Press) is nearly complete – it will go to copy editing this year, and should come out in 2026.

## Sabbatical Proposal between Lutheran Church of the Incarnation & Pastor Dan Smith, 2025

12-week sabbatical break from ministry – preaching, teaching, pastoral care and administrative duties

To begin: April 29, 2025 through Monday, July 21– ministry duties to begin again on July 22 (Tues)

This plan would replace the four weeks of vacation and two weeks of continuing education the congregation offers every year with a 12-week sabbatical, essentially adding an extra six weeks for rest and renewal.

Sabbatical activities to include: walking the "Camino de Santiago" in Spain – a pilgrimage by foot that has ancient roots in European Christianity. This is an opportunity for Pastor Dan to slow down, reflect on his life and ministry, and experience "Catholic Europe" for the first time. He would keep a journal, take photos to share with the congregation when he returns, and meet fellow pilgrims.

Also: a visit to Taizé, a village in France that is dedicated to building Christian community and social justice in our world, and is known for beautiful hymns and music. We sing many Taizé hymns at LCI, and this would be a chance to experience it first-hand, make connections with other Christian pilgrims, and potentially learn some music to share with the congregation on his return.

Lastly (possibly): a tour of Bonhoeffer sites in Berlin in late June. This is an event put on by a group called "Homebrewed Christianity". Pr. Dan could connect with other pastors and church leaders with an interest in Dietrich Bonhoeffer, and bring some knowledge back to the congregation.

In addition to time for rest and renewal, which is the point of a sabbatical, the activities in this sabbatical would enrich Pastor Dan's preaching, teaching and ministry leadership in the community at a time that could be challenging in terms of community relationships, political divisions and (potential) threats to vulnerable members of our community. Thanks for your consideration.

Costs (approximate):

- Airfare to Spain (two-way): app. \$1000 (Kayak) depends on exact dates
- Eurail Pass (10 days over two months): \$474
- "Rise of Bonhoeffer" tour late June: \$2450
- Week in Taize app. \$200

Approximate costs for sabbatical activities: \$4124.

I would invite a conversation about fundraising among the members at LCI to defray costs, as we did in 2017. I am in touch with Abajh Singh about helping again this year. I am grateful to Abajh for his help last time, and to the sabbatical planning committee for their support: Abajh, Ed Green and Tim Paulson.

#### Treasurer's Notes:

If you look at the 2025 budget final, I put in the 2024 actuals, so every can see. We had budgeted \$331,641.88 in total. We spent a total of \$306,540.17. (92.4%) We had total income of \$272,837.96. That left us with a deficit of \$33,702.21. We had insurance proceeds (from the accident that occurred on our property) of \$25,894.44, which offset the additional expenditures we incurred as a result of that incident. We had an additional unspecified expense of 253.35, leaving us with a deficit of \$8061.12.

Not counted in our income for 2024 are stock donations by Chris Bruhn. I estimate that we would realize somewhere in the neighborhood of \$16,000 if we were to convert these donations to cash, which would wipe out the deficit, and also help us make our 2024 contribution to the Synod. (I did not write the last contribution to the Synod yet.)
